




MAAC MIDAS MOTOR SKOU 2014 – Tertius du Preez

Die afgelope naweek kon motor geesdriftiges hulle weer verkyk aan allerhande skeppings wat ten toon gestel is op die jaarlikse MAAC Midas Motor Skou. Die skou wat deur die Maluti Antique Auto Klub aangebied word het sowat 400 motors vanoor die hele land gelok. Die Alfa klub van Natal asook Team Grumpy (Natal Cobra Club) het spesiaal Vrydag al deurgery vir die geleentheid. Volgens Frank Mawer van die Alfa klub was dit 'n goed georganiseerde skou. Hy sê dat die sentrale ligging vir hulle 'n samekoms van vriende geraak het wat wyd verspreid oor die land bly en hierdie geleentheid gebruik om mekaar weer te sien.



George Cumming van Cato Ridge vertel hoe lekker die rit in hul motors na Bethlehem en terug was. "Die organiseerders van die skou laat mens altyd so tuis voel en die mense van Bethlehem is vreeslik vriendelik. Die omgewing is baie mooi en dis hoekom ons elke jaar hierheen terugkeer." Lulu Allers, eienaar van Custom Cruises het saamgestem en gesê hulle beplan om van nou af jaarliks 'n toer van die rand na Bethlehem aan te bied. Hierdie groep het ook Fouriesburg, Clarens en Golden Gate aangedoen voordat hulle teruggekeer het na Gauteng.

Die oudste motor op die skou was 'n 1914 Ford Model T van Emil Kuscke wat spesiaal vanaf Pretoria na Bethlehem gery het. Die Reef Streetrod klub van Johannesburg het oudergewoonte die skou met hulle hitmotors bygewoon. Een van die lede het met 'n slagget langs die pad te doene gekry. Hy was heel verbaas toe een van die besighede, wat 'n uitstalling van gereedskap op die skou gehad het, aangebied het om hom Vrydagnag te help met reperasies sodat die motor saterdag ten toon gestel kon word. Twee filmspanne het al die gebeure insluitende die gewilde Vrydagaand braai verfilm.




Clive Craig en sy vrou Marthie was met hul Austin Healey en MG B by die skou. Clive sê sy swaer, wat die skou met 'n Porsche bygewoon het, gaan gereeld na motor skoue en hy sê dit was een van die beste wat hulle in 'n lang tyd bygewoon het. Die "Spectator Drives" was baie gewild. Dis die eerste keer wat dit aangebied is en bekende TV aanbieder, Stuart Johnston, het dit gelei deur 'n kort onderhoud met elke voertuig eienaar te voer.

Lede van die Secunda motor klub was baie beindruk hiermee. Tony Garces was in beheer van die meer moderne motors. Tesame met Team Streetglow en Max-my-Ride tydskrif het hulle 'n Sound-off asook Show-and-Shine kompetisie aangebied. Die gehalte van plaaslike motors is ook bewys toe twee van hulle met trofees weggestap het. Peet Joubert het 'n trofee in die Sound-off gewen terwyl beide sy motor asook Garces se Volkswagen Golf albei in die Show-and-Sound met trofees vereer is.



Volgens Danie Poggenpoel, een van die organiseerders, kon die militêre voertuig uitstalling, nie realiseer nie aangesien die voorafgaande reën en nat omstandighede die oplaai van die voertuie belemmer het. Die Mortimer Toyota uitstalling was beslis 'n groot trekpleister en baie indrukwekkend met die promosie vragmotor wat spesiaal vir die skou hierheen gebring is. Die nuwe Toyota Corolla is aan die publiek bekend gestel en mense kon vir 'n toetsrit in die motor gaan. Daar was heelwat stalletjies wat vir die hele gesin iets gebied het. Gereedskap en toebehore van enige aard is ook uitgestal. Stilstaande enjins wat enige plaasseun sou laat heimwee kry het, het atmosfeer geskep met hulle doef-doenf geluide.



Tertius du Preez, Voorsitter en organiseerder bedank almal vir hulle bydrae en teenwoordigheid by die skou. As gevolg hiervan kon 'n hele paar plaaslike liefdadigheids-organisasies ook baatvind waaronder KANSA, Epilepsie Suid-Afrika, Japsnoet kleuterskool en CTK. Tydens die skou is die Maluti klub se tiende bestaansjaar gevier terwyl Bethlehem Midas hul 40ste verjaardag gevier het. Daarmee saam is Bethlehem geluk gewens met hul 150ste bestaansjaar. Met Midas aanboord beplan die skoukomitee reeds aan die 2015 skou en vertrou hulle dat dit nog groter en beter gaan wees as ooit tevore.

FORD MUSTANG TURNS 50

The Iconic Ford Mustang celebrates its half Centenary around the world on 13 April 2014, and 50 of these will be on display taking over the main road – High Street at Melrose Arch Precinct. In association with MOCSA (The Mustang Owners Club of South Africa),

The Mustang created the Pony Car class of American automobiles, and in 1964 were launch priced at an average of \$2800.00 (R30 000.00) and some change, with some extra options available for \$371.00 (R 4 000.00).

It sold over 22,000 units in the first day and more than one million in two years, becoming one of the most successful product launches in automotive history. Since 1964, more than 9.2 million Mustangs would be produced and sold, most of them originating close to Ford's headquarters in Dearborn, Michigan, USA.

The first models came with 4 different ranges of power. Starting with the base 101 – horsepower, 170 – cubic inch six cylinder to the 4 barrel 289 cubic inch High Performance V-8 with 271 horsepower. The vehicle identification number for the first – ever Mustang was 5F08F100001.

First models rolled off the line in March – just in time for dealers to stock showrooms for the April 1964 unveiling. Over its lifetime, the Mustang has been many things, a fashionable boulevard cruiser, an asphalt ripping muscle car, a purpose built road racer, and stylish daily transportation for millions of buyers.

The next chapter in the life of the iconic pony car - 6 Generations later, with the all-new 2015, launching end of 2014, will boast a 3.7litre V6, and a 5litre V8, loaded with innovative technologies and delivering world-class levels of performance.

"Ford Mustang inspires passion like no other car. Mustang is definitely more than just a car – it is the heart and soul of Ford."

The open event will take place from 10h00-16h00, High Street, Melrose Arch Precinct, Corner Corlett Drive and M1 Highway, Melrose, Johannesburg

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SAVVA Technical Tip 83 – Fire extinguishers

By now you are most likely tired of articles about Fire extinguishers but this is not about having them on hand - but to making sure they work.

Recently, a well known collector of note was pouring petrol into the carburettor of a car to get it started when something drastic went wrong resulting in flaming petrol going in all directions. The covers on cars standing near-by also caught fire. They grabbed a fire extinguisher only to find out it was inoperative. Apparently, they were able to drag the burning covers outside and saved the cars but not before the gentleman was seriously injured and ended up in the burns unit of a hospital. Regretfully, he has subsequently passed-on.

Please check your fire extinguishers – don't assume they are in working condition and make sure you know how to operate them. Most have a pin and anti-tamper seal which must be removed before the unit will work.

Some of the smaller ones have a dial which indicates their condition; however, whilst these smaller ones are very handy and we can carry them in our cars we should also have much larger ones in our workshops. CO2 filled extinguishers are very effective, leave no mess when used and all have gauges.

It is a simple and inexpensive exercise to take your extinguishers to a fire extinguisher company every few years to have them checked.
